

# RE – How do festivals and worship show what matters to a Muslim?



<b>Allah</b>	The Arabic word for God. Muslims believe in one God.
<b>Fasting</b>	Giving up food and drink. This is done throughout the year but mainly during the month of Ramadan.
<b>Hajj</b>	Pilgrimage to Makkah to be made once in a life time if possible, this is the 5th Pillar of Islam.
<b>Muhammad</b>	The final Prophet who received Allah's message to the world.
<b>Prophet</b>	A messenger sent from Allah.
<b>Qur'an</b>	The Muslim holy book. For Muslims, the final revelation from Allah.
<b>Salah</b>	Ritual prayer carried out 5 times per day, this is the 2nd Pillar of Islam.
<b>Sawm</b>	Fasting from food or liquids during daylight hours in the month of Ramadan, this is the 4th Pillar of Islam.
<b>Shahadah</b>	The Muslim declaration of faith. It includes the beliefs that Allah is the only God, and that Muhammad is Allah's messenger.
<b>Zakah</b>	Giving of charity usually 2.5% of savings. This is the 3rd Pillar of Islam.
