## 1

### STATEMENT OF INTENT:



#### To Foster Strong Relationships:

- Foster collaboration with parents and carers for a stimulating learning experience.

#### Clarify Behavioural Expectations:

- Parents and carers must adhere to guidelines ensuring a welcoming, safe environment.

#### Enforce Zero Tolerance:

- No violence, threats, or abuse towards staff, governors, visitors, pupils, or other parents and carers.

### EXPECTATIONS FOR PARENTS AND CARERS:

#### Adherence:

- Follow the code of conduct at all times.

#### Support School Ethos:

- Reflect school's values and set a good example.

#### Collaboration:

- Work with staff for the child's benefit and resolve concerns peacefully.

#### Respect:

- Treat all school community members with dignity.

#### Clarification:

- Clarify issues peacefully and correct children's behaviour appropriately.

#### Property Respect:

- Keep the school environment clean and tidy, and no damage to property.

#### Parking Rules:

- Follow school parking and pupil drop-off/pick-up procedures.

#### Appropriate Dress and Behaviour:

- Dress suitably and behave appropriately at school events and whilst collecting and dropping off children.

### COLLECTING CHILDREN AT HOME TIME:

#### Late Pick-Up:

- Inform the school immediately if running late; call the office at 01773 712128, and do not contact via Weduc.

### INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR:

#### Zero Tolerance:

- Strictly no behaviour making anyone feel threatened or at risk (this includes staff, parents/carers, and children).

#### Unacceptable Actions:

- Discrimination against any school community member.
- Disrespectful behaviour, abusive language, aggressive gestures.
- Bullying, harassment, intimidation, online/offline abuse.
- Physical violence or intimidation (physical, emotional, and verbal).
- Security breaches, disruptive behaviour, trespassing, property damage.
- Inappropriate physical contact, arriving partially clothed.
- Confronting others about pupil issues or making threats.
- Engaging in harmful activities (smoking, drugs, alcohol, unauthorised photography).
