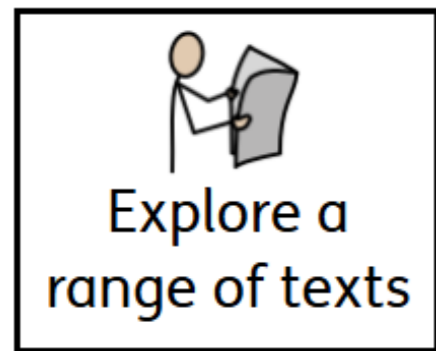




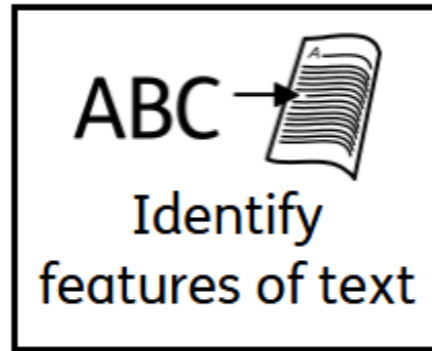
Writing at Greasley Beauvale Primary School



At Greasley, our aim is for *all* our pupils to be able to write effectively and with enjoyment. Our writing lessons are 'book based' using high quality texts and follow this sequence to ensure children have the tools they need to 'Learn, grow and succeed'.



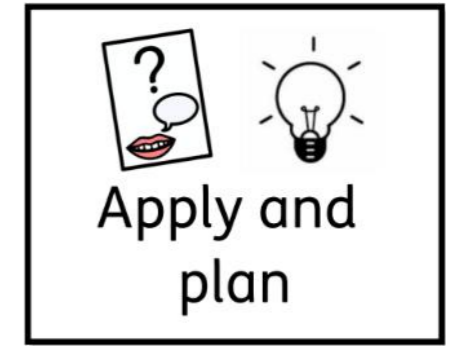
Introduce the type of text/genre children are going to be publishing.
Allow children time to read a range of texts in groups/pairs.



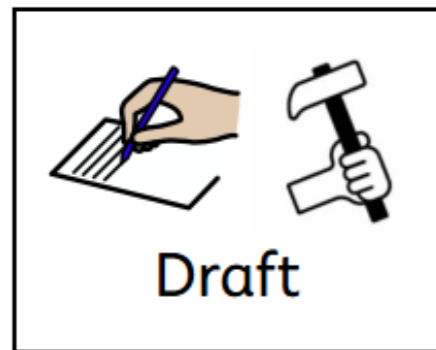
Children to identify structural and grammatical features of the text.
How do these features affect the reader?
Annotate example together to be displayed on working wall.



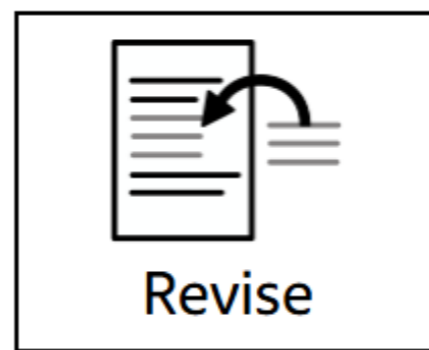
Children to be taught a sequence of lessons to teach them the skills of writing needed to match the text-type.
Lessons should allow time to produce writing that children can transfer to their independent writing.



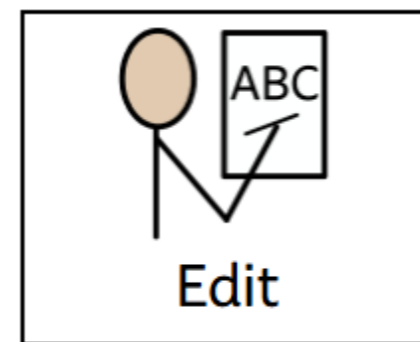
Revisit features before doing this stage.
Children to reflect on what they have learned.
Children to plan their final piece of writing.



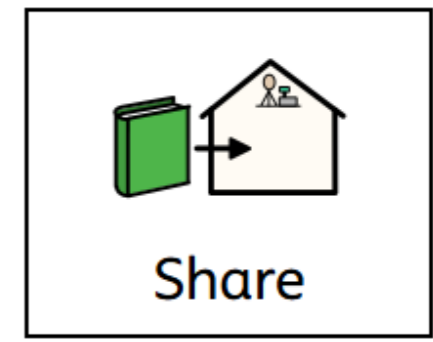
Children to use their plans to produce their piece of writing.
Teacher to model process (with a relevant but different example that cannot be copied)



Children to make changes to their writing using feedback and self-evaluation



Children to make changes to ensure writing is accurate and coherent, checking spelling and grammar.



Children to share/present their work for the target audience.
