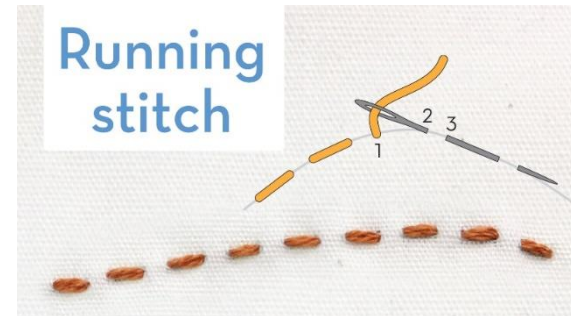


Textiles – Viking Coin Pouch

Key Vocabulary

Running Stitch	A simple stitch where the needle goes in and out of the fabric in a straight line, like dashes.
Overstitch	A stitch made over an edge or over another stitch.
Sew	To join pieces of fabric together or decorate them using a needle and thread.
Fastening	Something that closes or holds two pieces of fabric together, like a button, a tie or some stitches.
Viking	A person from long ago (over 1,000 years ago) who came from countries like Norway, Sweden and Denmark. Vikings were famous for sailing, trading and sometimes fighting.
Pouch	A small bag made of fabric that you can put things in and carry around.

Design Brief

Your challenge is to design and make a Viking coin pouch that is practical, functional, and looks like it could have been used in Viking times. A range of stitching techniques should be used to join pieces of fabric together to make sure your pouch is strong enough to hold coins and be used properly. Your design should be inspired by real Viking pouches using natural colours. Your finished Viking pouch should be neat, well-made, strong, and useful, as well as looking authentic and true to the Viking style.
