REMINDERS

SCHOOL DINNERS

A polite reminder that school dinners must now be pre-ordered on Arbor each day. Ordering closes at **8:45am each morning.**

This applies to all children, including those who receive Universal Infant Free School Meals (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) and those who are entitled to Pupil Premium Free School Meals.

As this is the first week back, staff have been checking the dinner registers until today. However, from next week, teachers will not be checking the registers which means if a school dinner has not been ordered on Arbor, it will be assumed that your child is having a packed lunch and a school dinner will not be provided.

Instructions explaining how to order school dinners through Arbor were emailed to parents earlier this week. If you need these instructions to be resent, or if you would like any support using Arbor, please contact the school office and we will be happy to help.

Thank you for your support and cooperation as we continue to streamline our dinner ordering process.

UNIFORM

EARRINGS AND PE

A quick reminder about earrings and PE lessons.

- If your child had their ears pierced over the summer holidays, please bear in mind that they won't be able to join in with PE lessons until they are able to remove their earrings themselves.
