Year 3 **Rainbow** Homework Menu

Spring 1

Complete at least 1 activity from each colour over the half term, plus all of the weekly homework activities. Record learning in the home-school diary, send through Weduc or hand it in as completed.

Final date for handing in homework this half term: Friday 6th February.

Writing: Watch a video of a natural disaster (e.g. tornado, earthquake, tsunami, volcano etc.) and create a word bank of verbs and adjectives to describe the event.

Geography: Research where volcanoes are around the world. You could plot these on a map or create a fact file to explain where they are found.

Science: Go on a minibeast hunt with your family and make notes of what habitats you can see!

Writing: Write a story from the perspective of a person who has experienced and survived a natural disaster. How did it begin? How did they feel? How did they escape?

Geography: Gather facts about famous natural disasters around the world and present them in an interesting way.

Art: Create a collage/ painting of a natural disaster (e.g. tornado, volcano, tsunami, storm etc.)

Writing: Write a setting description for a place experiencing a natural disaster.

Geography: Draw and label the key parts of a volcano.

D&T: Design and make a 3D model of a volcano.

Weekly Activities:

Reading: Read with an adult and record at least 3 comments per week in the home-school diary.

Spelling: By practising weekly, aim to learn to spell the first three columns of the year group words, over this half term.

Maths: Practise the 3, 4 and 8 times tables using Times Tables Rockstars at least 3 times a week.
